All works in Open Section, Novice and Under 18 Years to be MOUNTED and FRAMED WITH ATTACHMENTS, ready to hang. Size of work must not exceed 1200x900mm (4x3ft).

All care taken, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage to works.

The undermentioned information must appear on the back of the work:

a) Name, Address, Phone Number b) Title of Work, Price or NFS c) Class entered

Fine Arts must be painted in some way and be an "original work" of the exhibitor.

Judges are empowered to transfer an entry to another class if they feel it is more suitable to the entry, without disqualification to exhibitor
