HAND-SPUN SECTION

Conditions of Entry: Entries to be hand-spun and manufactured only by the entrant (any age).

Method: Knitting, crochet, sprang, weaving, other.

All entries to be labelled with: State Nature of Fibres used - nil synthetics. Provide a 2-metre sample of fibre used for each entry. State if home dyed (by entrant) using natural dyes, identify source. State dye mordant used in drying process. Nil commercial dyes to be used.

Any Article Using:

56. 5ply yarn for finer, equivalents

57. 8ply to bulky, equivalents

59. Over 6ply

State Competition

Class – Three different types of wool articles and /or garments CONDITIONS

1. For the purpose of this competition the following definitions apply:

a) Garment: an item that can be worn, e.g. a dress, jacket, scarf, hat

b) Article: a utility item that is not worn but can be used in the home, e.g. toy; as a decoration, e.g., picture etc.

2. The whole article and/or garment must be constructed of and contain a minimum of 80% wool.

3. Exhibits (articles and garments) may be knitted, crocheted, sewn, felted etc. and must be hand-crafted (use of machine is permitted).

4. A sample of the yarn, fabric or fibre with label must be attached to each item making up the exhibit. If a label is not available (as in a hand-spun/felted item) a handwritten label with relevant details and sample will suffice.

5. An exhibit in this competition may consist of the work of one individual or a group of individuals, or an organisation.

6. All three (3) articles/garments must have been completed within the 12 months prior to the local show and made by the exhibitors.

7. An exhibit having won at a local show may be exhibited (the same three article/garments) at the Group Final. The winning exhibit at the Group Final is then eligible to compete in the State Final.

8. An exhibitor is only eligible to represent one Society at Group level and one Group at State level.

9. An exhibit (article/garment) that has previously competed at Group level is not eligible to compete again.

10. If this class is not scheduled or attracts no entries at a local show, the Show Secretary (or delegate) may select three suitable individual exhibits and, with the exhibitor's permission, enter them in the Group judging as an exhibit representing the particular Society concerned.

11. It is the responsibility of the Group Secretary and winner to co-ordinate the transfer of the winning entry to Sydney for the State judging.
